



**Top Ten Things to Know About Alliant
October, 2010**

- 1. 2010 entering class includes students from 36 states and 46 countries.**
- 2. #5 in awarding doctorates to Hispanic students across all disciplines. As of 2010 we are (once again) a Hispanic Serving Institution (to be confirmed by the US Department of Education), meaning that at least 25% of our undergraduates are Hispanic.**
- 3. #1 in awarding doctorates in psychology to African Americans, Hispanics and Asian Americans.**
- 4. #9 in awarding doctorates in business to African Americans.**
- 5. Minorities comprise 27% of the student body.**
- 6. Women comprise 72% of the student body.**
- 7. Federal student loan default rate: 2.7%. National Average: 7%.**
- 8. Alliant was named a “military-friendly” university by GI-Jobs magazine, ranking us among the top 15% of colleges and universities working to create opportunities for veterans and active duty military personnel.**
- 9. Alliant is the only US university operating independently in Mexico City, and one of only two US universities operating in Japan.**
- 10. Alliant students contribute more than 1 million hours per year in community service through internships, field placements and service learning projects.**
