WASC Reaccreditation 2011-19

The university is pleased to report that the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) Commission determined that our University be reaccredited for 8 years, scheduling the next comprehensive review visit for spring 2019.

This is, indeed, good news. The award by the Commission of reaccreditation in general, and the number of years specified until the next comprehensive visit in particular, is a clear recognition of the considerable progress that we have been making toward fulfilling our mission and achieving our goals as a high quality professional practice university.

The Commission specifically noted:

“Accomplishments include the careful monitoring of retention and graduation rates; surveys of student satisfaction administered every other year; ongoing attention to diversity and multiculturalism through I-MERIT competencies; development of program-specific educational outcomes tied to Alliant’s Professional Practice Competencies, and the various and creative ways that faculty have identified for capturing evidence of the competencies; strong faculty engagement and involvement and an active faculty senate; and a dedicated resourceful library staff.”
